Introduction (Ephesians 6:10)

*Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power.* Throughout Ephesians, POWER is on the mind of the author. This text has three "power" words: *dunamai* / *kratei* / *ischuos*. This verse is a summary statement and an exhortation. Note the 'power' uses throughout Ephesians.

\* 1:19-21 RESURRECTION POWER is introduced. There are 8 English power words (drawn from 5 Greek power words). Power for what purposes?

\*3:7 (verses 7-11) Power for MINISTRY. For Paul's ministry...and yours...and mine.

\*3:16 Power released in the INNER MAN. Such power gives us:

1). An Awareness of the indwelling Christ (v. 17)

2). An Awareness of His love to us, in us, and through us. (v. 17-19)

\*3:20 WOW...the HUGENESS of this power.

Don't rush through this verse. Each word is important:

- He is "able"
- He is "able to do immeasurably more than we ask or imagine"
- "according to His power that is at work within us"

\* 6:11-17...Power for SPIRITUAL WARFARE. Three 'power' words in this paragraph:

1). Verse 11, "can" do what?

2). Verse 13, "able" to do what?

3). Verse 16, "can" do what?
