# **SERMON NOTES AND SCRIPTURE**

#### 1 Corinthians 13:9-10

9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part, 10 but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears.

#### 1 Corinthians 14:1-5

1 Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy. 2 For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit. 3 But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort. 4 Anyone who speaks in a tongue edifies themselves, but the one who prophesies edifies the church. 5 I would like every one of you to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be edified.

#### 1 Corinthians 15:20-21

20 But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man.

- 1. Any authentic gift of the Spirit must conform to the Bible's prescription for its use.
- 2. We don't all need to agree on the issue of spiritual gifts.

- Does this make you think twice about your role in edifying and building others up in the church?
- · Why is orderliness so important to the church?
- As we have looked at the Corinthian church and all they are working through, what do you think about them? Do you feel compassion for them? Do you see a bit of us in them?
