
SERMON NOTES AND SCRIPTURE

Luke 2:10-14

But the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.”

Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, “Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests.”

Please take a moment together as a group to read this Scripture passage.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Read verse 8. What about the glory of God do you think terrified them?
2. How have you seen God “bring peace to those on whom his favor rests?”
3. What does the favor of God look like?
4. Where has God brought about peace in your life where there was little before?
5. How does Philippians 4:5-7 add to this conversation? How have you experienced the peace that surpasses all understanding in your life?
6. How can our group pray for that peace in the circumstances in your life this week?
7. Take time and pray for peace in our world today. “Your kingdom come ...”
